## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### 1. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to junior female amateur golfers with an Australian Handicap from affiliated golf clubs and/or members of GA who are aged 18 years or under on 1 January 2011.

### 2. MATCH COMMITTEE

2.1 The Club Match Committee will have sole management and control of the event

2.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.

2.3 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.

2.4 The decision of the Club Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

### 3. RULES OF PLAY

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited, will apply together with the Local Rules of the Club.

### 4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entrants must conform with all aspects of the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited.

4.2 A fully completed entry form, together with the applicable entry fee must be received no later than 5:00 pm Monday, 3 October 2011.

4.3 In the event of entries exceeding the number of places available, entries from those higher handicapped competitors will be decided by ballot. Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entry fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not compete.

### 5. THE EVENT

5.1 The event will be played over 18 holes of stroke play.

5.2 The winner of the Rockingham Salver for Junior Ladies will be the competitor with the lowest gross score after 18 holes. In the event that there is a tie for the overall gross winner, a sudden death playoff will take place to determine the winner.

5.3 All other ties will be decided using the Australian Count Back System.

### 6. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

All entrants assent to be bound by the WA Golf Association's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at [www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml](http://www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml)

### 7. TEE OFF TIMES

Rule 6-3a provides "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this event that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes in stroke play rounds.

### 8. MOTORISED CARTS

The WA Golf Association's policy on the use of motorised golf carts and other similar vehicles will be enforced for the duration of the event. A copy of the policy is available at [www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml](http://www.wagolf.com.au/guests/memos.mhtml)

### 9. PRACTICE

One complimentary practice round will be provided on Friday 7 October 2011. Players must contact the Pro shop on 9592 4033 for bookings.

### 10. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

For this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

### 11. DRESS REGULATIONS

The following dress regulations apply during the event:

On course - Neat golf attire of collared shirt and trousers, tailored shorts or skirts. Shorts and skirts must be worn with predominantly white socks.

Golf Shoes - Only soft spikes may be worn on the course

Clubhouse - Golf attire and dress shoes
